

Hichibuku Goshinjutsu is a form of Japanese Natural Medicine, as taught by Hatsumi Soke (Head of the Bujinkan Dojo martial arts org.). It was originally taught as an integral part of warrior / martial training, but has now evolved into comprehensive system of natural healthcare & healing.

Hatsumi Sensei states the following:-

"Formerly, the method of medical called Hichibuku Goshinjutsu was learned as part of the process of acquiring Budo Taijutsu."

Peter King is one of only four practitioner to have received the highest level qualification of Menkyo Kaiden (Master Teacher's Licence) in Amatsu Tatara Hichibuku Goshinjutsu and to have been authorised to teach this art by Hatsumi Soke.

The British School of Traditional Japanese Medicine (One, Two & Three year courses in Hichibuku Goshinjutsu)

(Honorary Principal: Dr Hatsumi Masaaki)

Bujinkan Dojo Soke - Dr Hatsumi Masaaki has graciously agreed to act as the Honorary Principle of the British School of traditional Japanese Medicine. He is also the Soke of the Amatsu Tatara Hichibuku Goshinjutsu.

Hichibuku Goshinjutsu from the Amatsu Tatara tradition, is the system of Japanese Natural Medicine that Hatsumi Sensei inherited from his teacher Takamatsu Sensei.



The progression levels of Hichibuku Goshinjutsu are:

- Shoden
- Chuden
- Okuden
- Menkyo
- Menkyo Kaiden

Menkyo Kaiden is the highest level within this tradition. Hatsumi Sensei has only granted four 'Menkyo Kaiden' (Japanese - 'Master Teacher') licences in Amatsu Tatara Hichibuku Goshinjutsu and these are to: Peter King, Christopher Roworth, Dennis Bartram & William Doolan. These are the only four practitioners worldwide who have received teaching permission in this traditional health & healing system.

Peter King is the principal tutor at the British School of Traditional Japanese medicine. In addition to holding Menkyo Kaiden in Amatsu Tatara Hichibuku Goshinjutsu, he holds Ku-gyo Menkyo (the highest level rank) in Bujinkan Dojo Happo-hikenjutsu, he was also the first Bujinkan black belt and the first Shidoshi in the UK.

Peter also holds a Master of Arts (M.A.) degree in 'Sports Science & Japanese Budo Studies' and is also a:-

Peter's background has enabled him to develop a 'Hichibuku Goshinjutsu' - Japanese Natural Medicine programme that is appropriate to both medical / healthcare professionals and fellow Bujinkan practitioners.
